Things to Remember:

School Timing:

8.15 – Dropping time

12:30 - Picking time

Terms:

The school year is divided into 3 terms:

- Term 1- September December
- Term 2- January March
- Term 3- April June

Note: Each term is allotted with two themes.

Attendance:

- Not more than 5 days of leave.
- No leave can be guaranteed after opening of the classes.
- No leave allowed before and after the holidays.
- Below 95% of absence will mean NO PROMOTION.
- Medical certificate to be attached if it is a sick leave.
- LEAVE:
- 1-3 days Inform Homeroom Teacher.
- 5 days or more Inform Head of KG.
- 15days or more-Inform Ministry
- Apply for a leave and attach the medical certificate.

Classroom Visit:

- Parents are not allowed to visit the classroom during class hours.
- Parents can meet the teacher at 12:45pm only with prior appointment from the front office.
- Parents are not allowed to talk to the teacher during dispersal time.



No Comparison:

All students require the same basic educational development therefore;
 students are treated equally regardless of nationality, status, or creed.

Accessories:

- Wearing of jewelries should be strictly avoided.
- No responsibility will be taken for any loss.

Uniform:

- Regular uniform
- P.E Uniform (according to the class time table)
- School ID card.
- White shoes and socks (for P.E) and Black shoes with white socks with regular uniform.
- School's jacket during winter.

Classroom requirements:

- **BOOKS:** The books are collected and kept in the school for the whole academic year.
- Note books should be covered with plastic and labeled.
- Kindly label all your children's belongings and winter jacket also.

Diary:

• It should be sent to school every day .Proper use of diary should be made for sending messages to teacher and vice versa. The 1st page &2nd page should be filled completely.

Circular:

 The circulars should be read carefully and where necessary, acknowledge and send to school the next day.

Open house:

 It is compulsory for the parents to attend the parents' teachers meeting to know the performance of the child.

Visits, events, Activities and Outings:

• It is conducted in every term. The child should be sent in regular uniform .They have to carry lunch box, tissue /napkin /wipes, sanitizer and cap.

Competitions:

- Children should be encouraged to participate in all the competitions held in school.
- Certificates to be awarded for the first three positions.

Assessments:

 The kindergarten has no marks/grades. The child is being assessed through daily observation and after each theme on the EYFS Rubrics.

Birthday Celebrations:

NOTE: NO cake, pastries, donuts or freezy drinks allowed. Children's can bring Chocolates.

Parent can make it a more special day for their child by donating reading books for library on your child's birthday or come as guest speakers or readers and do some fun activity.

Other concerns:

EXTRA DRESS: One extra set of clothing should be always in the Childs bag for emergency purposes.

SNACKS: Send only healthy and enough food for the child to eat. (NO CHIPS & FREEZY DRINK)
