Tips for a happy and fruitful vacation:



Compose a poem making an appeal to everyone to save "Mother Nature".



Save The Water

$$\text{Average consumption of water} = \frac{\text{Total consumption of water for 15 days}}{15}$$

TASK - 4

Draw 3 different types of 3-dimension/ solid shapes and write their names.

In your view, which of these shapes would be more convenient to store water? Why? Give examples from your surroundings and paste pictures also.

Which shapes are used in your home to store water? Also, write the estimated amount of water stored in it.
