



The Mathematics Department of AJB organized a maiden edition of a Live Math Competition on the 21st of January 2020.

The day had arrived and the all was set for the event and both the organisers and students were ready. Competitors started trooping into the hall as early as 7:30am as the event was scheduled to commence 10 minutes later.



The event began with an opening speech from the Head of Department Mr. Azmathullah Khan who congratulated the contestants on their courage to participate in the event. Soon afterwards the competition began at 7:50am. The Timer was clearly displayed for the contestants to see as they set to work.
