




When teachers use activities that make learning engaging and fun, students are more willing to participate. Having fun while learning also helps students retain information better because the process is enjoyable and memorable.


Education is a must, and fun learning can help make it more interesting for both teachers and students.

Storytelling competition was held at Al Ain Juniors kindergarten. The objectives of the event were:






- ✓ To build up the confidence in the children to stand in front of the crowd and tell a story.


All KG students participated in the descriptive writing competition exhibiting their excellent writing, imaginative and creative skills.



# STAR OF THE WEEK


Awards help boost the children's self-esteem and confidence. Offering these throughout the year and at the end of the school year helps keep everyone's spirits up.


Celebrating milestones and educational achievements helps give children a sense of accomplishment and pride.
