In this regional round at Al Ain, students will undertake different academic and social challenges and demonstrate their skills to connect History, Science, Art, Literature, Social Studies, and Current Affairs etc.

World Scholar's Cup Round consists of four main events:

The Scholar's Challenge - a test called the Scholar's Challenge: an opportunity to win individual medals and other prizes across multiple subjects.

Collaborative Writing - work with the team to argue positions related to the theme in written form.

The Team Debate - teams from other schools argue motions related to the theme.

Scholar's Bowl - will race the clock to answer questions using a special clicker.

In addition to these four main events, non-competitive activities take place, these activities are both social and academic, and are intended to provide a friendly atmosphere for participants.
