- One of the main benefits of Light sail is its comprehensive library of 6000+ engaging and
 age-appropriate books that students can read on any device. This library includes a mix
 of fiction and non-fiction titles, as well as books in multiple languages. Students can

SPREAD YOUR WINGS INITIATIVE: -skill courses for Middle School students

Alain Juniors in compliance with CBSE has decided to offer students the flexibility of making a vocational choice of a short duration module, of 12 hours for each module, at a stage in their early academic career (either at Class 6, 7 or 8). In this way they will be able to spend relevant time period pursuing this choice as per convenience of school, while benefitting from access to courses that are broader based. This would give them the necessary orientation early on, so that they are able to make a choice at a later stage to pursue Skill courses at Secondary and Senior Secondary level, or choose a higher vocational degree.

In essence this flexibility will keep multiple career possibilities open for each student, instead of the current situation of rigidity once the first choice is made.

- Mass P.E and life skills Social Emotional Learning -SEL have been incorporated in the time table.

<u>Light Bag Policy at AJ has been implemented In accordance with ADEK & CBSE recommendation</u> on reducing the weight of School bags which has an adverse effect on the health of the students.

- 1. Weight of school bag will be monitored and checked on a regular basis in the school. For this, school will keep a digital weighing machine in the school premises.
- 2. School bag needs to be light-weight with proper compartments and contain two padded and adjustable straps that can be squarely fit on both the shoulders. Wheeled carriers not to be promoted as it may hurt children while climbing stairs.
- 3. When more than one textbook for the same subject are prescribed, students should know which of the textbooks is to be used on any particular day. This information should form part of the official school time table and is not to be followed by both students and teachers.
- 4. Sharing of textbooks among students may be promoted for non-language subjects,.
- 5. PTMs shall be organized regularly to inform parents about student learning and behavioural progress and spread awareness about the school bag.
- 6. The school will inform parents of their responsibilities regarding the bag policy to ensure that the bag weight is appropriate before sending students to school.
- 7. NO Bag days will be organised once a month for all classes, where students will learn through task sheets or BYOD.

1. Updated Fee Policy

Our faculty has diligently prepared innovative curriculum enhancements, engaging extracurricular activities, and enhanced support systems to cater to the unique needs of each student. To facilitate this, we have made some changes to our Fee Policy. Please note the following:

- Re-registration fee: This fee is part of the tuition fee and helps the school to confirm and reserve places for the continuing/promoted students. It is payable before the start of the new academic year along with the first instalment fee, in the month of April. First instalment includes:
- Re-registration fee
- Tuition fee for April
- MOE books fee
- Transport fee (if availing transport service)
- To confirm the enrolment for the new academic year, the first instalment must be paid in full **before the first day of school**.

2. <u>Discontinuation of Bank Transfer Mode of Payment</u>

- a. Starting from July 2023, the 'Bank Transfer' mode of payment will no longer be an option for payment, in order to avoid confusion and miscommunication.
