Dear Parents,

We are pleased to announce that we will be renewing our partnership with Française and offering DELF exams for beginners at the A1 and A2 levels at Al Ain Juniors School. This is an exciting opportunity for students to showcase their French language proficiency and obtain a recognized certification.

Who can participate?

Students from Grades 8-12 are eligible for Levels A1 and A2. Higher levels of B1,B2,C1 and C2 can be continued at any stage later on through Alliance Française anywhere in the world.

When?

The first national session will be held on May, 27th 2023 in Al Ain and Dubai.
Registration forms must be finalized by Wednesday, 1st March, 2023.

What is the Fees?

Registration fee this year is 430 dirhams, in cash through your class teacher or online payment.

We would like to emphasize that taking up this program through our school has several benefits, including significant cost savings compared to other accredited institutions. External courses of this nature typically cost between 2000AED – 4000AED per level, including exam and materials fees. The French facilitators of Al Ain Juniors School will take up the responsibility of preparing candidates for this Diploma Course.

It is worth noting that French is an official language in nearly 50 countries, including Canada. It is spoken by over 200 million people on five continents and is an official language of the United Nations, the Red Cross, and many other international organizations.

The offers of the DELF exams are:

- 1. The certification is based on an international standard used in 164 countries (CEFR), facilitating dialogue across Francophone countries.
- 2. A testimonial to one's success in learning French:** The certification recognizes the candidate's achievements and progress towards French proficiency, and is an official document recognized internationally that can enhance the candidate's school or professional portfolio.
- 3. Advantages for post-secondary education:** The certification is recognized by Francophone post-secondary institutions, including a growing number in Canada and French-speaking European countries. Candidates with a B2 or higher level can even be accepted into universities in France.
- 4. Enhances one's resume:** The certification provides a detailed description of the candidate's French language skills and abilities, which can be helpful for professional advancement and open doors to various career and recreational opportunities around the world.
